

Refill Instructions

1. Read the instructions fully first before using the ink refill kit.
2. Put some newspaper down in case of any spillages.
3. Seal the outlet hole with an adhesive tape.
4. Remove the label on the top of the cartridge to find the filling holes.
5. Fill the syringe with 10 ml. of black ink / 3ml per colour for colour ink cartridge, dependant on which cartridge you are refilling. These are guidelines as it all depends on if the cartridge is fully empty or not.
6. Start injecting the ink into the cartridge slowly through the corresponding filling holes (see below diagram).

Note: You may feel a slight resistance due to the sponge existing in the cartridge

7. The cartridge is full when the ink starts to overflow, stop injecting at this time and suck any excess ink back into the syringe.
8. Replace the label back to block the hole.
9. Return the extra ink to the bottle.


Note: You must wash the syringe and needle between colour changes. Ensure there is no water left in the syringe or needle.

10. Leave the cartridge for over night standing on a non-absorbent surface to make sure it doesn't leak and to give the ink the time to saturate the sponge inside. Please ensure you are careful when leaving overnight if any ink was to come out of the cartridge it doesn't spill over the area you have left it.
11. Next morning wipe the cartridge print head to remove any excess ink and ensure there is no further ink coming from the print head. Install the cartridge to the printer and run a cleaning cycle.

Note:

- For best results, once the cartridge is empty refill it immediately before the remains of the ink dries.
- You may need to reset the ink level monitor; to turn it off please consult your printer manual, if you press the STOP/RESET button for 5-8 seconds.
- Pre check the colour refill holes prior to refilling as some cartridge that come with the printer from new may have a different configuration to cartridges purchased from a shop . Use the needle to probe into the holes and you should have some ink residue on the end of the needle to see what colour is in what hole. Be careful not to push too far into the sponge.
